20 plemental grants for fiscal year 2008 to metropolitan  
21 areas that received grant funding in fiscal year 2007  
22 under subpart I of part A of title XXVI of the Public  
23 Health Service Act to ensure that an area's total funding  
24 under subpart I of part A for fiscal 2007, together with  
25 the amount of this additional funding, is not less than

1 91.6 percent of the amount of such area's total funding  
2 under part A for fiscal year 2006, and to transitional  
3 areas that received grant funding in fiscal year 2007  
4 under subpart II of part A of title XXVI of the Public  
5 Health Service Act to ensure that an area's total funding  
6 under subpart II of part A for fiscal 2007, together with 2 year  
7 the amount of this additional funding, is not less than  
8 86.6 percent of the amount of such area's total funding  
9 under part A for fiscal year 2006: *Provided further*, That,  
10 notwithstanding section 2603(c)(1) of the Public Health  
11 Service Act, the additional funding to areas under the im-  
12 mediately preceding proviso, which may be used for costs  
13 incurred during fiscal year 2007, shall be available to the  
14 area for obligation from the date of the award through  
15 the end of the grant year for the award: *Provided further*,  
16 That \$822,570,000 shall be for State AIDS Drug Assist-  
17 ance Programs authorized by section 2616 of the Public

19 amounts provided herein, \$25,000,000 shall be available  
20 from amounts available under section 241 of the Public  
21 Health Service Act to carry out Parts A, B, C, and D  
22 of title XXVI of the Public Health Service Act to fund  
23 section 2691 Special Projects of National Significance:  
24 *Provided further*, That, notwithstanding section 502(a)(1)  
25 and 502(b)(1) of the Social Security Act, not to exceed
